FOREST MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT AREA**

Pursuant to The Forest Resources Management Act

APPROVAL NO. 21/22-PAFMA-SAKÂW-OP1

WHEREAS:

1. Sakâw Askiy Management Inc. is a registered company in the Province of Saskatchewan, hereinafter referred to as Sakâw.
2. Pursuant to Section 35 of The Forest Resources Management Act Sakâw was granted rights to harvest through issuance of a forest management agreement.
3. Section 38(1)(b) of The Forest Resources Management Act provides that prior to commencing any activity authorized by a forest management agreement; the licensee shall submit to the minister for approval a five-year operating plan.
4. Pursuant to the December 1, 2020 submission and March 19, 2021 follow up, Sakâw has submitted an operating plan consistent with the Forest Operating Plan Code Chapter D.1.3 and the associated Forest Operating Plan Standard.
5. Sakâw and its Shareholders agree to the terms and conditions of this plan and this approval as recognized by the following signature of a company representative.

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NOW THEREFORE:

Pursuant to Section 39.1(2)(a) of **The Forest Resources Management Act**, the Minister of Ministry of Environment (ENV) hereby approves Sakâw's 2021-2026 Operating Plan on the Prince Albert Forest Management Agreement Area subject to the terms and conditions set out in this approval.

General Operating Conditions

1. All Forest Management Plan (FMP) references within the 2021-2026 Operating Plan are to the approved version of the 2018 Sakâw FMP.
2. Actual timber volumes harvested by Sakâw and/or its shareholders from the available volume approved in this plan, shall not exceed the volume for a 5 year cut control period as determined in the 2018 Sakâw Forest Management Plan (FMP). The 5 year cut control volumes are those allocations described in Schedule F of the Amended and Restated Prince Albert Forest Management Agreement (PA FMA). Changes to the allocations must be approved in accordance with Article 4.05 of PA FMA.
3. Shareholders must operate consistently with harvest profile VOITs established in the FMP.
4. Sakâw and/or its shareholders shall operate in accordance with the approved Forest Operations Standard dated July 8, 2020, unless an updated Forest Operations Standard is enacted, in which case the updated Standard becomes effective immediately upon being signed into effect.
5. Year 1 block design for all harvest blocks as identified in tables 1 and 2 are approved subject to conditions within those tables.
6. Until such a time that code, standards or FMPs address the issue of retention and in-block structure being left, harvest of all blocks is to be fully integrated with forest products for all shareholders being removed in a single entry and align with the current approved FMP/VOITs. General increased hardwood retention is approved in accordance with the Ministerial approval of June 22, 2020. In any blocks where excessive hardwood will be left, Sakâw must submit notification to the Area Forester prior to harvest.
7. Sakâw and individually specified shareholders are responsible for all operational activities as outlined in table Sakâw_Operating_Plan_Proposed_Harvest_Tables_Year 1-2021- to Year 5-2026-Detail Resubmission_Draft_v2 and must meet all regulatory requirements.
8. For all activities outside of harvest blocks e.g., roads, crossings, and signage both the softwood and hardwood shareholder in the operating zone will be responsible for those activities unless otherwise identified to the Area Forester prior to harvest with evidence that all shareholders are aware of this responsibility i.e., notification must come through Sakâw and go to all shareholders. In instances where operational activities cannot be tied to a shareholder or in the instance of vacated shareholders Sakâw is ultimately responsible.

9. Sakâw and/or its shareholders shall comply with the terms and conditions of the approved Aquatic Habitat Protection Permit # 21/22-PAFMA- SAKÂW-AHPP01 issued on March 31, 2021 for all crossings constructed, maintained or reclaimed under the authority of the permit.
10. Sakâw and/or its shareholders shall comply with the terms and conditions of the approved Temporary Work Camp # 21/22-PAFMA-SAKÂW-TWCP01 issued on March 31, 2021. Prior to establishment of temporary work camps Sakâw, with agreement from shareholders, must identify the shareholder responsible for each camp. Upon establishment all camp locations must be provided to the appropriate inspecting officer.
11. Sakâw and/or its shareholders shall operate in accordance with the approved Temporary Work Camp Standard dated July 8, 2020, unless an updated Temporary Work Camp Standard is enacted, in which case the updated Standard becomes effective immediately upon being signed into effect.
12. In accordance with Section 39(1) of The Forest Resources Management Regulations (FRMR) all forest products harvested in the 2021-2022 operating year are approved to remain in year 1 harvest areas and storage sites identified in **21/22-PAFMA-SAKÂW-MUP1** until March 31, 2022. Forest products intended to be staged or stored at locations beyond March 31, 2022 are identified as potential areas in Appendix C of the executive summary for this plan. Shareholders through Sakâw must identify and submit for approval by January 15, 2022 the actual locations from the anticipated harvest areas/storage sites, the estimated or requested volumes to be stored at those locations and the anticipated date the timber will be removed from the sites. All approvals granted under the authority of 39(1) of FRMR will be forwarded to the Forest Service Scaling Unit for approval to exceed 90 days to scale in accordance with section 48 of FRMR.
13. Sakâw Askiy Management Inc. must provide one consolidated weekly update of active shareholder harvest operations on the PA FMA or provide acceptable access to their system so that Forest Service PA FMA staff can view weekly operations.
14. In the event the ministry becomes aware of new information in the future that indicates potential adverse impacts to Aboriginal or Treaty Rights, Sakâw and/or its shareholders may be required to revise operating plans accordingly.

15. In accordance with Section 58(2) of The Forest Resources Management Act, Sakâw and/or its shareholders, employees and contractors are approved to access any closed roads located within the FMA area for the purpose of conducting approved forest management activities. Once forest management activities are completed roads shall be closed in accordance with the approved PA FMA Standards and Guidelines of the day.
16. For all active company roads Sakâw and/or its shareholders are approved to control vegetation on the right of way as per the Forest Operations Standard effective July 8, 2020 unless there is an update to the Standard, then the update takes effect immediately on being signed into effect. For all non-company roads or inactive company roads separate approval is required to damage or destroy vegetation in the ROW of such access.
17. Unless otherwise specified in this approval or an amendment, all class 3 roads used for harvest under authority of this operating plan are to be reclaimed along with the in-block roads in the blocks they access including pre-existing class 3 roads which must be reclaimed to the same status as prior to harvest.
18. Any new or reopened access in regenerated areas must have that access reclaimed and silviculturally treated with the blocks they are accessing.
19. Seed mixes used for the purpose of stabilizing soils associated with stream crossing reclamation shall comply with the approved 2021-2022 aquatic habitat protection permit. Seed mixes shall not be used for other purposes without prior authorization from the Area Forester.
20. Upon approval of the plan all stakeholder engagement and commitments are conditions of this plan. Following approval all stakeholder engagement and commitments must be submitted to the Area Forester in a monthly report including nil reports for months with no changes and will be deemed conditions of this plan. If there are alterations to these commitments evidence of alternative measures agreed to by the stakeholder prior to harvesting must be made available to the Area forester upon request
21. **“Utilization standards”** - as approved in the 2018 Forest Management Plan. This will supersede utilization standards identified within the Amended and Restated Prince Albert Forest Management Agreement Schedule H unless specific pieces of schedule H are not addressed in the FMP then those portions of schedule H apply.

22. For the purpose of mistletoe control in identified mistletoe control blocks, the Forest Operations Standard green tree retention requirements are waived. Shareholders should attempt to achieve green tree retention targets with species not susceptible to dwarf mistletoe. Sakâw is also approved to sanitize mistletoe pine adjacent to the approved block as long as the patch does not exceed 5% of the block size or 2 ha whichever is less. Maps of treated areas must be sent to the Area Forester ASAP.
23. For the purpose of mistletoe control in identified mistletoe control blocks, the Forest Operations Standard retention requirements are waived for RMAs. Shareholders should attempt to achieve green tree retention targets with species not susceptible to dwarf mistletoe. As well, the 10 m no travel zone is amended to a 5 m no travel zone.
24. Sakâw shareholders harvesting pulpwood under the 2021/2022 approval must have authorization from Paper Excellence to take the pulpwood and track it against Paper Excellence's TSL volume. Otherwise, Sakâw must identify to which shareholder the volume will be assigned upon completion of the harvest block. If there is no longer a pulp allocation (licence) then authorization is not required.
25. Sakâw and/or its shareholders are exempt from standards 1, 2, 3 & 5 of the Planning of Visually Sensitive Lakes section in the PA FMA VSA Standards as long as visual quality objectives are declared for blocks on visually sensitive lakes unless visual quality objectives are in an approved land use, forest management or operating plan as per the Forest Operations Standard.
26. For the purpose of employee safety during compliance assurance activities, prior to commencement of any operations on Provincial Forest Lands, the shareholders must provide all haul radio frequencies and channel names, with permission for use, to the Ministry of Environment, Forest Service.
27. For all roads other than provincial highways the radio frequency and channel name being used for haul must be clearly identified at the start of the road.
28. For all road classes 1 through 3 and primary class 4 roads kilometre signs will be placed at minimum every 2 km on the roads that have active haul when the road length is more than 2 km unless otherwise specified in a licence or standard. In cases where class 3 or 4 roads create a loop where traffic is expected to flow in a specific direction; directional markers, e.g. arrows, will be placed at intersections to indicate flow of traffic.

29. All shareholders of Sakâw will operate in compliance with the Harvest Block Layout Boundaries section of the Forest Operations Standard effective July 8, 2020 unless an updated Forest Operations Standard is enacted, in which case the updated Standard becomes effective immediately upon being signed into effect.
 - i. For ribboned boundaries, portions of the Forest Operations Standard Harvest Block Boundaries still apply, including deviation requirements.
 - ii. Ribbonless boundaries are operational and all mapped boundaries are to be maintained with no deviation tolerance; and other portions of the Harvest Block Boundaries section of the Forest Operations Standard are to be met.
 - iii. For ribboned boundaries all other portions of the Forest Operations Standard Roads and Harvest Block Layout requirements still apply including deviation requirements.
30. All blocks adjacent to Hwy 924 (Dore Road) require a 100 m buffer unless evidence of alternative measures agreed to by the stakeholder is provided to the area forester prior to harvesting.
31. No harvest operations are approved in Tier 1 caribou habitat management areas.
32. Forest operations in Tier 2 caribou habitat management areas shall not occur during calving periods (April 1 to July 31) unless otherwise approved by the Ministry of Environment.

Area Specific Operating Conditions

The following section pertains to area specific operating conditions and Table 1 identifies all blocks approved, while Table 2 identifies blocks with conditions. All area specific conditions must be adhered to.
