Additional approvals to remove vegetation in areas outside of approved blocks and active company rights of way in the 2023-2024 operating year are required.

<b>Special Conditions:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Sakâw and its shareholders are accountable for all activities carried out at any work camp covered under the authority of this permit. Sakâw must identify to the Forest Service the shareholder responsible for each camp prior to the establishment of said camps.</li> <li>2. Forest Officers must be kept informed of camp locations within one week of establishment.</li> <li>3. Sakâw must abide by conditions officers add to this permit, the “Temporary Work Camp Standard of November 14, 2022” and section 17 of <i>The Wildfire Act</i> and section 5 of the Wildfire Regulations when it comes to burning at camps.</li> <li>4. All fires must be contained to burning barrels and only wood and paper products are permitted to be burned. All conditions set forward in the Sakâw 2022-2023 operating plan and approvals apply to this permit</li> <li>5. Any environmental code chapter or provincial standards developed during the timeframe of this permit take precedent over other conditions unless otherwise legislated.</li> </ol>	
<b>Subject to provisions of:</b> <i>The Provincial Lands Act, The Forest Resources Management Act, The Environmental Protection Act 2010, The Wildfire Act, The Public Health Act and associated Regulations.</i>
